1.0	Purpose of Report
1.1	This report is to seek approval for proposed scale of charges in relation to Operational Cemeteries for the period 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019.
2.0	Background
2.1	The proposed charges for Property Services relate primarily to the administration and operational arrangements of burials in Council's five active cemeteries.
3.0	Main Report
3.1	Council has an obligation to provide cemetery services. Detailed below is a summary of

the main cemetery operations for the 12 month period up to November 2017:

The proposed scale of charges are based on a 5% increase on existing charges (rounded to the nearest pound). In respect of items 1-3 it is proposed that in cases of 3.3 non-residents these charges are doubled. Non residency is verified by the Funeral Director/Undertaker. The proposed charges have been identified following consideration of those currently in place, and are not set on a cost recovery basis. It should be noted the costs associated with management of Council cemeteries are increasing due to increased memorial safety inspection and repair requirements, and further physical development requirements to facilitate future burials.
