
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY STATEMENT OF OUR PROJECT

"OUR CLUB DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN ITS DEVELOPMENT, IMPLEMENTATION AND FUTURE USE WILL SERVE AS A RANGE OF IMPORTANT FACILITIES FOR OUR CLUB MEMBERS, LOCAL AND WIDER COMMUNITY IN MID-ULSTER, HELPING MID-ULSTER DISTRICT COUNCIL MEET ITS RESPONSIBILITIES TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF RURAL NEEDS"



The location and design of the project has placed our club and community at the forefront of the planning process: this will enable the three elements of the project to be delivered for their benefit.

- I. **spectator stand** with a capacity for 800 people;
- 2. play park (approximate area: 14.5 sq. metres x 14 sq. metres) that will encourage activity among young children. It will include essential items such as a soft surface, swing, slide and climbing frame;
- 3. ball wall (approximate area: 18 metres wide x 5 metres high) will be used extensively by our members
 across age generations to practice Football, Hurling and Camogie skills.




