3.5	There was a high level of scrutiny, over a two day period, of our waste management records (as demonstrated by the attached NILAS audit report) however it is pleasing to note that the report concludes that <i>"overall the examined information held by Mid Ulster District Council was found to verify the data as inputted to WasteDataFlow, was well organised and subject to structured internal checks".</i> It was also pleasing to note that during the recent waste management facility inspections
	in the Dungannon area, that no non-compliances with site licence conditions were recorded by NIEA inspectors (see attached site inspection reports).
