


What is Dementia?

The term 'dementia' is an umbrella term to describe the symptoms that occur when the brain is affected by specific diseases and conditions







Dementia – the facts



- 19 765 people in Northern Ireland have dementia
- 1 317 people in the Mid Ulster Council area with dementia
- Estimated one in three people will experience dementia
- Dementia costs the UK government over £26 billion each year
- Family carers save the UK over £11 billion a year
