10.1 Councillor Molloy to move

'That Mid Ulster District Council recognises the recent achievement of Dungannon broadcaster, Lynette Fay, on winning at the Irish Film & Television Academy awards in the category of Best Live Event and that given this is a National Award, due recognition should be the form of a Civic reception.'

10.2 Councillor Cuthbertson to move

That this Council notes the destructive nature of Japanese Knotweed and the problems home and landowners are facing as a result of it. Carries out a survey of all Council owned lands to establish the extent of this problem in Mid Ulster.
