#### BACKGROUND

- Summer 2015 Management inform NIPSA about budgetary pressures and possible implications
- January 2016 NIPSA provided copy of proposals paper – preferred option is centralisation
- NIPSA seeks financial information to justify closure of regional electoral offices – denied

#### **INDUSTRIAL ACTION**

- NIPSA members balloted in April 2016 92% turnout 95% support strike action 100% support action short of strike action
- Meetings at Labour Relations Agency
- Strike on 03 & 07 June

## **Political Engagement**

- Significant political support
- Motion debated and passed at NI Assembly
- Meetings with First & Deputy First Ministers
- Meetings with MPs, MLAs & Councillors
- Meetings sought with NI Affairs Committee and Secretary of State

### What Regional Electoral Offices Do

- Assembly, Westminister and European Elections
- Referendums
- Electoral Identification
- Voter Registration
- Promoting Voter Participation

#### **Local Councils**

- Plans at early stage
- Chief Electoral Officer has spoken with all 11 Local Council Chief Executives
- Councils to take over all Elections
- Councils to provide an Electoral Identification service
- Councils to provide a Voter Registration service

#### What Councils need to do?

- Remember the NI Assembly motion retain six regional electoral offices
- Actively engage Chief Electoral Officer
- Get a fully costed business plan for transfer of any electoral services
- Respond to any Public Consultation process
