# Context – Local Area

- Vibrant rural community off A 28 Augher- Aughnacloy Road
- 81 pupil local primary school
- Woodlands Pre and Afterschool Club
- Tourism Resource





# Community

- St Patricks Primary School, enrolment of 81 pupils
- Redeveloped in 2016/17 with 3 new classrooms, office and kitchen /dining room & ground works
- Woodland Pre and After School, 51 children enrolled
- On the newly developed Carleton Trail & Ulster Way
- Strong farming and business community

# Broadband Action Group

- Area suffers from very poor broadband service
- New USO regulates for 10mb download speeds
- Residents average 0.8 – 1.5 mb download
- Community meeting pre Christmas attended by over 40 householders.
- Addressed by Airfibre reps

# Options

- BT FTTP – 69 Homes at cost of £107,807 on contract reduced to £77,807 (Primary School)
- Airfibre 30 Homes at a cost of £33,600
