Mid Ulster Recycling Rate At 60%

Provisional figures show Mid Ulster's overall recycling rate stands at 60.1% for the first quarter of 2017-2018, up from 55.3% for the same period last year and the best of all the 11 councils here.

The statistics show that the people of Mid Ulster are making a huge recycling effort, using their blue and brown bins effectively.

Christmas Bin Collections

As Christmas Day falls on a Monday, all bins due for collection that day will now be collected on **Saturday 23 December**.

Bin collections will be as normal on Boxing Day (Tuesday 26 December) and New Year's Day (Monday 1 January).

Our recycling centres will close only on Monday 25 December and Monday 1 January.

Please remember to always leave your bin out for collection by 7.30am every morning!
