1.1	To advise members of Full Fibre Project implementation.					
2.0	Background					
2.1	The council are part of a consortia of 10 Council and Business Services Organisation(BSO) who have now contracted with Fibrus to implement dark fibre to Council and NHS premises across the district through the full fibre NI project funded through DCMS and managed by Newry & Mourne District Council.					
3.0	Main Report					
3.1	The council has engaged with Fibrus ( and their third-party contractors including Openreach ) to complete site implementation surveys. At the time of this report Council has adjusted the number of sites within the eligible scope of the programme , currently agreeing wayleaves and the details around some implementations and assessing the accommodation and buildings for the fibre.  The following sites have been descoped for various reasons such as sold, lack of accommodation/need for fibre and no building present and BT Openreach refusing to install in cabinets provided by Council. To date, following adjustment the Council has now 80 sites within the project see appendix 1. Implementation is currently on track. Several wayleaves are to be completed to allow installation and a second substantial claim and drawdown are expected to occur in October subject to validation.

Further to the P&R report presented to Council in February and May in relation to the management costs, Newry and Mourne District Council(NMDC) are currently maintaining the actual and project administration and technical support costs within the revised budget.

As part of the project Council will seek to work with Armagh Banbridge and Craigavon Council (ABC) in procuring wide area network (WAN) and MPLS services over the installed fibre and provide testing certificates for all sites as part of the project verification. Officers are currently refining the requirements of the services and the potential to share a procurement with ABC at present to light the fibre and run services over same.
