Start360 Multi-Component Model

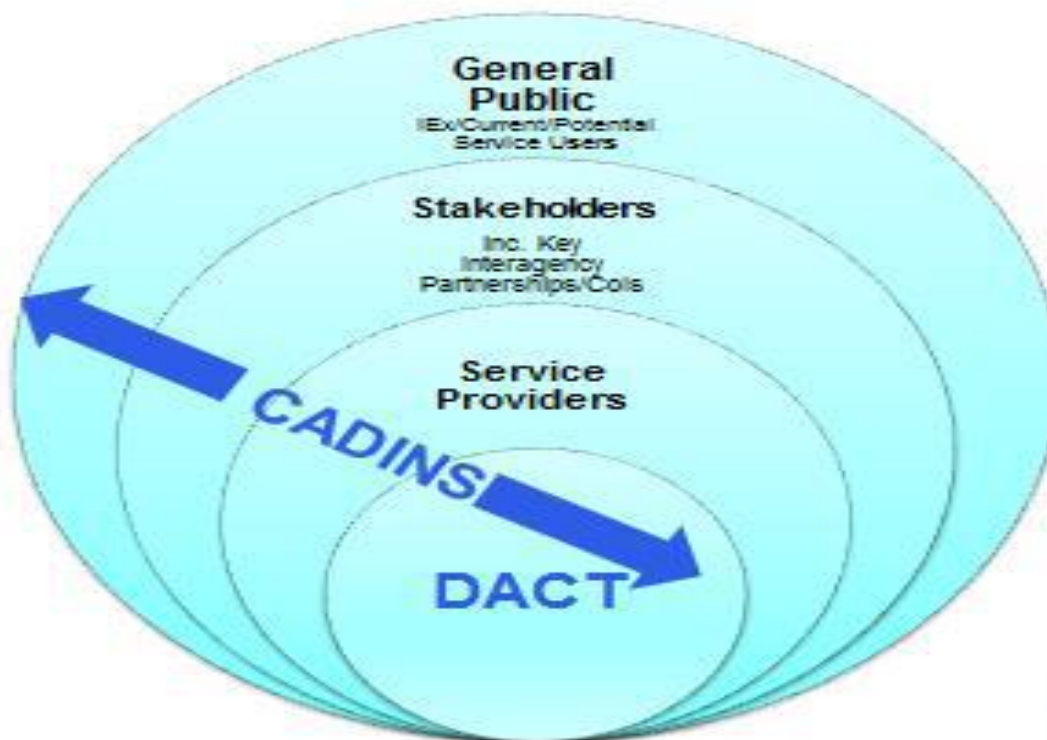
