- Shapes the priorities for all proposed changes to education provision, for the period 2017 -2020
- Developed through partnership working between school managing authorities and sectoral support bodies
- Implemented through Area Planning Groups strategic and local partnership groups



Key Issues Emerging from Analysis of Current Local Provision in Mid Ulster, 2017-2020

- Number and location of available school places
- Schools facing sustainability challenges
- Equitable access to Entitlement Framework pathways for all post-primary pupils
- Potential for Irish Medium and Integrated school development in the district
- Potential opportunities for shared education development in the district
- Need to establish additional learning support provision within mainstream schools in the district

Primary Schools: Sustainability issues

- Culnady PS proposal to discontinue the school with effect from 31 August 2019
- Lisfearty PS proposal to discontinue the school with effect from 31 August 2019
- Desertmartin PS proposal to discontinue the school with effect from 31 August 2020
- Churchtown PS proposals to be developed following engagement with school community
- Provision of sustainable schooling in Coagh/Stewartstown area: Ballytrea PS, Coagh PS, Stewartstown PS



Annual Action Plan 2018/19 - Mid-Ulster Primary Schools - Increase in enrolment

- Aughnacloy PS proposal to increase the admission and enrolment numbers
- Gaelscoil Aodha Rua
- Killyman PS
- Dungannon Area review of potential impact of BREXIT - due to the large number of newcomer pupils currently in schools



Annual Action Plan 2018/19 – Mid Ulster

Post Primary Schools - issues

- Ensuring adequate future provision
- Ensuring equitable access to the Entitlement Framework

Strategic area solutions being developed for:

- Magherafelt Area: Sperrin IC and Rainey Endowed GS schools are taking forward proposals to increase their admission and enrolment numbers
- St Joseph's GS, Donaghmore potential increase in Irish Medium provision
- Dungannon Area review of potential impact of BREXIT due to the large number of newcomer pupils currently in schools



Annual Action Plan for 2019/2020

- Culmination of work carried out by Area Planning Local Groups and the Regional Area Planning Working Group
- 2019-20 Action Plan will be submitted to Department of Education for endorsement – late February 2019
- Contact with schools affected by 19/20 Action Plan March 2019
- Annual Action Plan for 19/20 published late March 2019

Shared Education Partnerships

35+ partnerships across 80+ schools in the area

Extended School provision

10 clusters of schools offering extended provision in the area

Promoting community use of schools

Support and advice available from EA

Re-constitution of Boards of Governors

New Boards coming into place across all schools, for a 4 year term of office



Other EA led developments

Introduction of on-line applications for pre-school and primary school places

One example of increasing digitalisation of EA services

School Enhancement Programme

Significant schemes at Dungannon PS, and Kilronin School, Magherafelt, to upgrade and extend accommodation



Other EA led developments

Working with DE and CCMS to develop and implement a 'Transformation Programme' for education

- Team in place which includes seconded school principals
- Initial transformation projects focus on:
 - Area Planning increasing the pace and developing approaches
 - Digitalisation of services
 - Strategic Review of Pupil Support Services
 - Provision of maintenance and minor works services
- EA working to secure greater funding and support for transformation of the education system
