





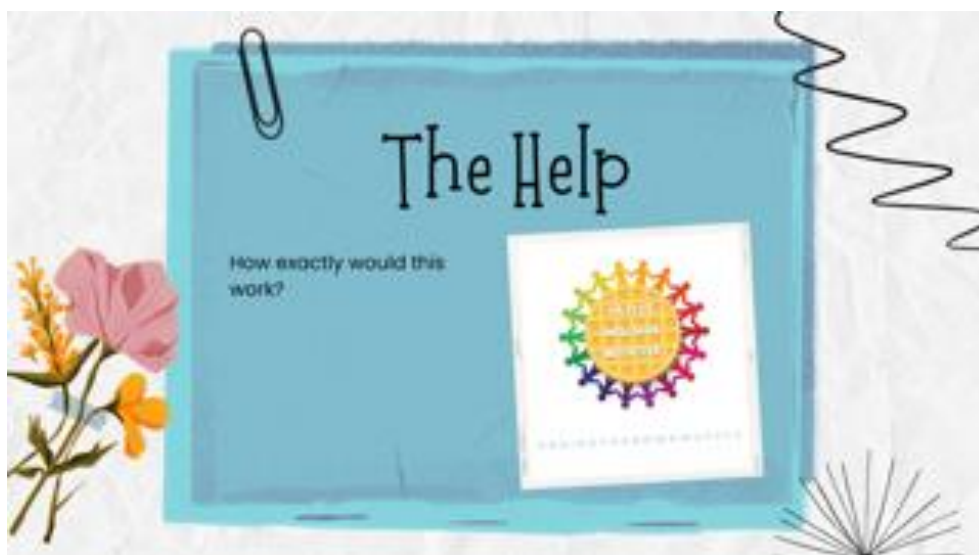


Could this work?
