2.1	Dungannon Park parkrun was set up in 2018, with the first run taking place on 18 August 2018.
2.2	Dungannon Park parkruns take place every Saturday morning at 9.30am, as is the same as the rest of NI. The parkrun is wholly organised by a group of volunteers.

3.1	The following gives a breakdown of statistics for Dungannon Park parkrun, (as of 23 September 2019): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dungannon Park has hosted 57 parkruns. • There have been 1,557 different runners take part • There are on average 99 runners per week • The highest no of runners in 1 week was 205. This was on Saturday 17th August 2019 when the team celebrated their 1st birthday. • The runners have totalled a distance of 28,330km
