All decisions will be undertaken either by:</p> <p>(i) Planning Committee Or (ii) Planning Manager under the scheme of delegation.</p> <p>Where a decision is made under the scheme of delegation it will be the Planning Managers responsibility to ensure decisions are made in accordance with the policies of the Council and that the right checks and balances are in place</p>
